To help portray the Club in a good light we ask that you follow these simple steps for the enjoyment of all.

- Young people take part in sport for their own enjoyment.
- Young people are not professional entertainers.
- Do not harass or swear at players or officials.
- Do not harass your child during a game; remember they are part of a team.
- The manager is there to help the player and the team.
- If you have any input or problems talk it over with your child's manager.
- Never ridicule children or young people for making a mistake. We are all only learning.
- Encourage children and young people to play to the rules.
- Respect other decisions.
- Condemn the use of violence in all its forms.
