Team Managers' Coaches & Club Officials.

To help portray the Club in a good light we ask that you follow these simple steps for the enjoyment of all.

On and off the field I will;

- Show respect to all others involved within the game.
- Adhere to the Laws of the Game.
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.
- Always respect the match officials' decisions.
- Never enter the field of play without the match officials' permission.
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success.

When working with players I will;

Remember that children and young people play for fun.

- Place the well-being, safety, and enjoyment of each player above all else.
- Explain what is expected of players and what they can expect in return.
- Ensure that parents/carers of the players, under the age of 18, understand these expectations.
- Refrain from and refuse to tolerate any form of bullying.
- Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own actions, and respect all others behaviour and performances.
- Ensure that all activities are appropriate for the age, maturity, ability level, experience of the players under their care.
- Co-operate fully with all others in football in the player's best interests. This is to include officials, welfare officers, doctors, or physiotherapists.

As a team manager, coach or Club official you have an important role to play in the Club's responsibility towards the acceptable behaviour across the whole game of football.

Please understand that if you breach the Club Code of Conduct, action may be taken against you by the Club, the County FA, and/or The FA.
